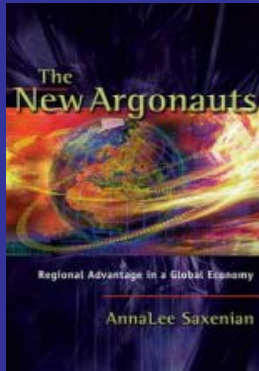


Interesting Facts about Indian Diaspora

- 23 Billion USD a year in remittances from 30 million Non Resident Indians disbursed in 130+ countries.
- The Overseas Indians worldwide produce an economic output of about \$400 billion approx. 30% of India's GDP
- Indians make up roughly 20 percent of the "International Medical Graduates" - or foreign-trained doctors - operating in the U.S.
- 26 percent of all immigrant-founded companies in the past 10 years were founded by Indian immigrants.

Is this phenomenon contributing to India's Current Economic Growth of 9%?

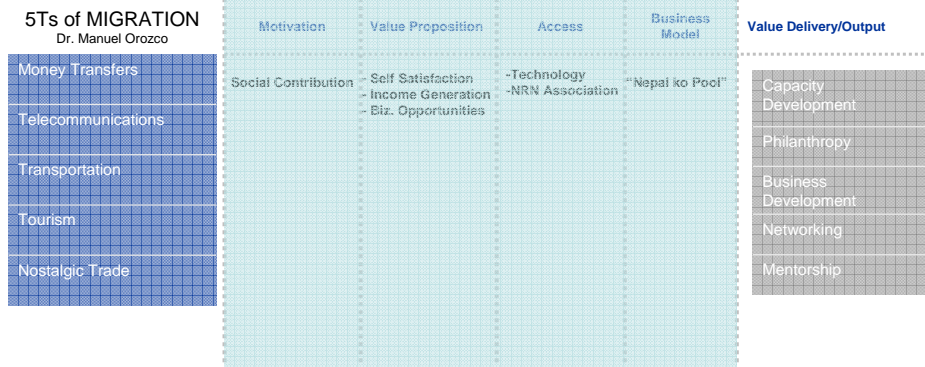
