

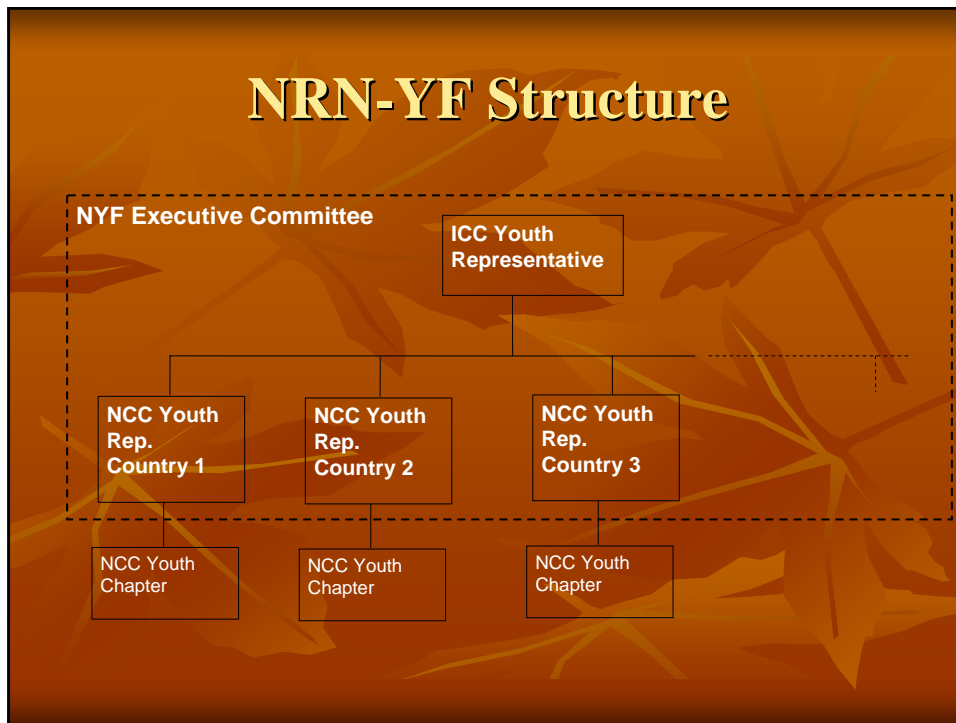

 - At least one meeting with outside client.

How It Works.. Contd..

- Intern will prepare following report(s) and presentation(s)
 - At least one presentation to the employees of the company.
 - A monthly progress report
 - A final report that describes the internship, tasks completed, lessons learnt and suggestions for the Program improvement.
- Participate in the program for a minimum duration of six weeks.
- Compensate the interns with a nominal salary, ten percent of which will be attributed to running the program.
